



CRITERIA FOR FUNDING GRANTS

Requests from agencies, institutions, and organizations in any part of North America may be considered for grants from Wildlife Forever (WF). WF reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, the eligibility of a project for support.

Requirements for submitting grant applications are as follows:

- Completed application form
- Letter of Determination from IRS stating 501(c)3 nonprofit status of requesting organization
- Letter of approval from appropriate state or federal agency
- Copy of requesting organization's annual report and/or publication
- Wildlife Forever grants are challenge grants, and funds must be matched on at least a one-to-one basis from a third-party donor and sent through Wildlife Forever.

Wildlife Forever favors supporting projects in the following areas:

- Enhancing wildlife and fish populations through acquisition, research, and management
- Conserving and enhancing wildlife and aquatic habitat
- Promoting wildlife and fish habitat and quality
- Watchable Wildlife-related projects

Wildlife Forever **does not provide monies for:**

- Individuals
- Political activities
- Loans of any kind
- Endowment purposes
- Trips, tours, tickets, or advertising
- Salaries, stipends or general program operations
