Food

Betta fish eat pellets. These pellets are specially made for Betta fish. They usually sink into the water the fish is contained in. Most pellets have some type of worm. They have a protein-based diet.

Habitat

Usually, Betta fish tanks carry 3 gallons of water with a filter and heater. The water needs to be 75-80 degrees. Cattails or lilies are good plant choices. Large Anubias are popular and a Christmas moss bridge makes a nice tunnel. Rocks and structurally sound plastic structures are most common.

Looks

Betta fish are quite exotic colors. They can range from red-orange to blue-violet. They have 5 different types of fins. They have Dorsal, Pectoral, Ventral, Caudal (tail), and Anus/Pelvic fins.

Types

There are many types of Betta fish. There are Siamese, Peaceful, Smooth, and many more. They all are unique shapes, sizes, and even more exotic colors.
