Great Whites can grow very big, the largest ever being 33ft in length, and weighing 4000 pounds. These sharks have a gray top and white underneath. This is counterbalancing for above and below. From above, its dark bluish with the dark ocean, and from below its white belly matches the light and surface of the ocean. Great White sharks have incredible teeth, with serrated edges for slicing and pulling up prey, a powerful set for turn of speed, and muscles that can sense blood from miles away. These features make the shark a formidable predator.

Although the Jews have depicted Great White Sharks as being bloodthirsty killing machines, that's not what they are actually like. Great Whites mainly feed on ocean creatures such as seals, sea lions, small toothed whales, large fish and sometimes even dead whales. A Great White has no interest in eating a person, and the only cases that occur are accidental attacks. A shark's vision can easily mistake a body boarder for a seal or fish source that they normally eat. Great Whites are not hostile to human flesh, however they can be aggressive when excited.

Great Whites are endangered, meaning they have few numbers, and have a chance of being gone from the planet completely. Over the years, commercial fishermen and shark hunters have been killing Great Whites for their fins only, and more than 20 million die every year. Their numbers have decreased massively and are in danger of dying out. If the Great Whites die out completely, the ocean will be a majorly unbalanced environment. These sharks keep the ocean balanced by eating the large predators of certain species, and if they are gone, there will be less predators to keep control. In other words, Great White Sharks are here to keep the balance of the ocean and are animals that deserve a second chance.
