

I've got 6 interesting fact about the rose-veiled fairy wrasse.

① It's also called *Cirrhilabrus finlaysoni*

② It was first discovered in the 1990's but was thought to be the adult of the species *C. rubiginosus*

③ The rose-veiled fairy wrasse is only 7cm long

④ It's named after a flower since finlayson means rose in Hindi

⑤ When it's seen in the dark it's fluorescent pink around the head and fins and dark purple for the rest

⑥ Because it lives from 50-150 meters deep from the surface of the Indian Ocean you won't see it
